Puyallup fairgrounds needed an arena for their livestock exhibits for their fair. We have built 3 buildings on the Puyallup fairgrounds. We are a trusted vendor to them. To erect the building, PermaBilt® had to dig the holes for the posts through the fairground asphalt. And later on, Washington State Fairgrounds (formerly know as Puyallup) fairgrounds added a fence around the arena as well as a grandstands to one side. After its completion, they named the building “Town & Country® Arena 2.”

And just like the Washington State fairgrounds, more and more commercial and specialty building purchasers are choosing post frame construction as the method of choice for their light industrial building needs. The wide range of building models and flexible design features, coupled with low costs and safety benefits, make post frame buildings a great option for a myriad of business types.
