

Three Car Garage - 22949



Many of our customers come to us having outgrown their current garage and need a new one to fit all their new vehicles. Having bought a high end RV, our Sequim customer needed a garage that he could not only house his RV but his family's cars as well. He saw a building advertised in the local paper but the advertised special wasn't quite what he needed. In order to get the middle door as tall as possible, the customer chose our coffer trusses - maximizing the door height without raising the eave height of the building. The customer also wanted to make sure that he'd have enough room to park his boat in the future. In the past, he had to park his boat at an angle for it to fit. At the time he didn't have a boat, but was making sure it would work for when he did get one.

Our crews efficiently erected the building and the customer had the storage he needed.

Details:

- Building type: Garage
- Building size: 36' x 34' x 12'
- Location: Sequim, WA
- Concrete floor: 36' x 34' x 4" with fibermesh reinforcement and zip-strip crack-control
- Apron: 10' x 36' x 4" with fibermesh reinforcement and zip-strip crack-control
- Garage doors:
 - 9' x 10' raised panel steel overhead door with Stockton lites
 - 12' x 12' raised panel steel overhead door with Stockton lites
 - 10' x 10' raised panel steel overhead door with Stockton lites
- Walk-in door: (2) 3' x 6'8" PermaBilt® doors with self-closing hinges, stainless steel lockset and one with 3' x 3' concrete pad
- Window: 4' x 3' double glazed white vinyl slider with screen
- Accessories:
 - 18" eave and gable overhangs
 - Gutters and downspouts
 - (2) 24" x 30" rectangle gable vents
