Details:

- Building type: Storage Warehouse
- Building size: 40' x 124'
- Location: South Snohomish County, WA
- Concrete floor: 40' x 124' x 4" with fibermesh reinforcement and zip-strip crack-control
- Garage doors: (2) 10' x 10' and (1) 12' x 16' raised panel steel overhead door
- Walk-in doors: (2) 4' x 6'8", (2) 6' x 6'8" double doors, (3) 3' x 6'8" fire doors, (1) 6' x 8'8" fire door
- Windows: (4) 6' x 3', (2) 3' x 3', (4) 8' x 3', all double glazed sliders
- Accessories:
 - Fully insulated
 - (2) 10' ridge vents
 - Gutter and downspouts
