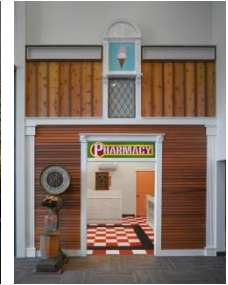


Marysville Historic Museum- 23575

- Building type: Commercial
- Building size: 84' x 92' x 24'
- Location: Marysville, WA

 - Ivory (side)
 - Sierra Green (trim)
 - Mocha Tan (roof)
- Concrete Floor: 84' x 92' x 4" with fibermesh reinforcement and zip-strip crack-control
- Garage Door: 12' x 8' insulated carriage house, long panel w/ Stockton Lites
- Walk-in Door: 3' x 6'8" PermaBilt® door with self-closing hinges and stainless steel lockset
- Entrance door: 6' x 6'8" glass storefront with transom window
- Windows: (13) fixed, mill finish .35 U-Factor of various sizes
- Accessories:
 - (2) 30" round gable vent
 - 4' wide staircase
 - eave and gable overhangs
 - enclosed vinyl soffits
 - 4' wainscoting entire perimeter
