

## Goat Barn - 24630



This customer wanted a proper home for their goats as well as a farm storage building. They decided a horse barn pole building was the perfect place to house their small herd with an extra horse stall to store their goat and chicken feed as well as room for the herd to grow. With a fully enclosed storage for their small tractor, the design was complete. After some modifications to the original design to allow the building to fit into the space allowed by the permitting jurisdiction without removing any trees, they had the new home for their goat herd. Needless to say, the goats are very happy with their new living quarters.

- Sliding Door: 12' x 8' Sliding door
