

High-Low Shop - 26783



Our customer in Lewis County called us looking to build a pole building shop on their beautiful property overlooking the mountains in Vader. Given the vast size of the property and equipment the customer owned, we immediately started designing a building that would accommodate his need to store equipment, house, a workshop, and accommodate a future living space the customer was interested in. With all of that in mind, the customer and our building representative designed a “High-Low” pole barn. The final design incorporated two lean-tos on either side, one to act as a covered porch, and one for an outside storage area for hay, firewood, or equipment. The customer is extremely happy with their new post frame building and the value it will bring, having a place for his work, hobbies and on an already great property!

- Concrete floor: 36’ x 74’ x 4” with fibermesh reinforcement and zip-strip crack-control

- Walk-In Doors:
 - (3) 3’ x 6’8” PermaBilt® door with self-closing hinges and stainless steel lockset
 - (1) 6’ x 6’8” PermaBilt® doors with self-closing hinges and stainless steel lockset
- Windows:
 - (2) 4’ x 3’ Vented Low E

- Garage Doors:
 - (2) 10’ x 10’ raised short panel, non-insulated, with rope opener
 - (2) 10’ x 12’ raised short panel, non-insulated, with rope opener
 - (1) 12’ x 12’ raised short panel, non-insulated, with rope opener
- Accessories:
 - Bird blocking at both gables
 - 18” full perimeter overhang
 - 10’ Obscura vent
 - 24’ to peak interior wall
